It's about reaching a generation with the hope of Jesus and then mobilizing them to reach their peers until every teen, everywhere, has every last chance to put their faith in Jesus."

Starting on November 11, 2023, youth around the world will be activated to pray, serve others, and share their faith. Inspired and trained through creative video content, attendees then go out and serve their local communities, sharing the Gospel with their friends and neighbors. The impact will spread as young people are inspired and take the Gospel to their world. Currently, there are over 2000 youth groups from 70 countries signed up signed up to participate.

Over the past 32 years, Dare 2 Share has inspired and equipped millions of Christian teenagers and youth leaders to engage in spiritual conversations through conferences, training curriculum and resources. Through the Dare 2 Share LIVE training event, Dare 2 Share is mobilizing a youth-led evangelism movement that will activate students with the mission Jesus gave His people, to reach their generation for Christ.

Dare 2 Share President, Debbie Bresina, shares, "This is the largest youth population in history. By leveraging technology, these young people have the opportunity to ignite a significant movement of Gospel conversations on one day. Our vision is to see every teen, everywhere, hear the Gospel message from a friend so this global expansion is a significant step in that direction."

This is the beginning of a global movement with local impact as communities are impacted by the Gospel and teens are transformed as they share their faith.

Today, D2S offers a global video-based training event, weeklong summer evangelism and discipleship intensives, books, curriculum, youth leader trainings, and more to realize the vision of every teen, everywhere, hearing the Gospel from a friend.
