**What does the accomplished vision look like?**

**Jesus’s accomplished vision: Matthew 24:14**

- How does this team help accomplish the mission?
- What is their role in bringing about the vision?

- **DETERMINE NEED**

**Does the bold vision require more workers to accomplish it?**

**Jesus’s mission: John 3:17, Luke 19:10**

- How do you see student leaders benefiting your ministry?
- Are you willing to change the way you do things?
- Are you willing to take your hands off and trust students to carry the ministry?
- Is there a need for a student leadership team yet?

- **ESTABLISH STANDARDS**

**Whom do you call to be a part of the team?**

**Jesus’s standards: Luke 6:13-16**

- What rules do you need?
- Are you prepared to give grace?
- Are the students a priority over the program?



- **BUILD STRUCTURE**

**How will you send them out?**

**Jesus's approach to sending: Luke 9:1-2, 10:1**

- What hands-on roles do you want them to serve in?
- What are your expectations for each team?

- **PREPARE FOR TROUBLE**

**Jesus's approach to team trouble: John 21:19**

- How do you avoid cliques?
- How do you avoid "scandal"? How do you respond to it?
- What do you do if student leaders don't live up to the role they agreed to step into?
